Currently, the software is cross compatible with multiple operating systems, and will work on Motorola's PocketPC 2003, Windows CE 4.2, Windows Mobile 5.0 and Windows CE 5.0 devices.

How it Works

There are two basic ways the push-to-talk technology can work on your devices: "Full-duplex" or "Half-duplex" mode.

- Full-duplex mode allows both users to talk at the same time.
- Half-duplex mode works like a walkie-talkie where one person can talk and the other listens. It works very much like the popular Push-To-Talk phones.
